# Here's how to plan your gift

JNF welcomes gifts of all sizes, as every gift makes a genuine difference. But where to begin this momentous journey?

**Below are the five steps to planning your gift to JNF:**

## 1. Seek expert advice

When preparing a new Will or amending your current one it's important that you consult your legal and financial advisers to ensure that your personal situation is considered and your wishes are followed.

## 2. Speak to our honorary solicitor

JNF can refer you to our honorary solicitor, who can advise you and draft your Will. If you decide to leave a gift to JNF in your Will, our honorary solicitor can prepare a simple Will. Depending on your circumstances, this service can be provided in your home.

## 3. Define your gift

**You can leave a gift to JNF in one or more of the following ways:**

- A fixed sum or percentage of your estate
- The whole or part of the residual of your estate
- The proceeds of a life insurance policy or superannuation benefit
- Particular assets or items of value (such as property, shares, bonds, managed funds, works of art)
- A trust or endowment fund

## 4. Decide how you want to assign your gift

**Your gift can be:**

- Unconditional, meaning it will be used for general purposes (the funds will be used wherever they are required at the time they are received)
- Directed to a particular area of our work that has special meaning to you or your family

## 5. Recipient details

It is necessary to use the correct terminology.

- ✓ Your name will be recorded and remembered every year in our Yahrzeit notice in the Australian Jewish News.
- ✓ If the amount of the gift is \$18,000 or more, a plaque will be inscribed with your name (and those of your loved ones if you choose) in a Yahrzeit memorial area in Israel to acknowledge your support.
